GM PNM Item No. 31/10

Sub : Regularization of Shri Pritpal Singh, Welder GR. III  
Under Dy. CE/C/UMB from the date of attaining  
Temporary status.

Shri Pritpal Singh S/o Shri Jeewan was initially engaged as Casual Welder on 4/10/1984. Temporary status granted as Welder w.e.f. 3/10/1985 in grade Rs. 260-400 ( 3050-4590 ) in terms of Railway Board L.No. E/NG/11/84-CL/41 dt,1/6/1984. The employee was issued Medical Fit Memo No. 90134 dated : 11/11/1986 for appointment as Welder. In this connection, post facto approval for his appointment in Casual Labour as welder was given by GM/P Baroda House, New Delhi vide letter No.220E/190/C-IV/Facto/94/011/E.I dated : 4/9/1995. Further CAO/C/K.Gate conducted screening and declared Shri Pritpal Singh fit as Khalasi vide L.NO. E/83/Const/V/UMB dated : 3/1/2/1997.

Shri Pritpal Singh challenged the screening in the Hon'ble CAT/New Delhi , and Court of Law passed orders in favour of the employee as under :-

“Respondents are accordingly directed to organize screening of the applicant in skilled category instead of Class IV post (unskilled ) and regularize them as such in case they are found suitable “

To comply with Court orders, Ambala Division conducted the Trade Test and declare Shri Pritpal Singh, Fit and accordingly regularized him w.e.f. 1/10/2000 as Welder Gr. III in grade Rs. 3050-4590 and DRM/UMB's letter No.911/2000/P-III dated : 1-102000, whereas he was to be regularized as Welder from the date of attaining temporary status i.e. 3/10/1985 and his name is required to be interpolated in the seniority list of 10/85 as welder in grade Rs. 260-400 ( 3050-4590 ( RPS ) as per hon' ble CAT,s decision.

Union, therefore, urges that Shri Pritpal Singh,Welder working under Dy. CE/C/UMB, having been initially engaged as Skilled Welder on Casual basis , be regularized as such , retrospectively, all consequential benefits.

GM PNM Item No. 32/10

Sub : Provision of Attendance Register for Class IV  
Staff being covered by Muster Sheets.

Union desires that orders for implementation of Attendance register instead of Muster Rolls be issued for keeping the attendance record of Class IV Staff being covered by Muster Sheets, as the salary bills are being prepared through Computer to avoid wastage of paper and manpower, particularly for the Gang Staff.

GM PNM Item no 33/10

Sub : Decentralization of E.D.P. Centre.

It has been represented to this Union that EDP Centre usually are situated at Divl. And Hqrs. Office level, while staff who will prepare the bills of Salary and other bills through Computer is posed elsewhere. They face lot of problems when deputed to work of Data Feeding of Salary bills by seating on the seat of other staff of EDP Centre . There is already shortage of staff and computers in the situated EDP Centre s, more over staff face too much problems to run so long distance in the train due to heavy rush .

Union, therefore, demands that EDP Centres may be decentralized at the main working stations of N.Railway at the earliest.

GM PNM Item NO. 34

Sub : Compassionate ground appointments cases.

There have been complaints from all corners that compassionate ground appointment cases are being delayed on one plea or the other. Some of the cases are given below which needs sympathetic consideration so that the deceased's family may heave a sigh of relief during these hard days

1. Compassionate ground appointment to Shri Hari Pal Singh adopted son of late Shri Ram Bharosey Ex. CNL Porter under CHC/RAC-MB Division.

One Shri Hari Pal Singh adopted son of late Sh. Ram Bharosey Ex. CNL Porter under CHC/RAC vide application dt.6/1/10 which was forwarded to DRM/MB through Union's letter No. NRMU/MB/Divn/HRI/10 dated : 9/1/2010 and since then the Union at Divl. Level is pursuing the case but to no effect.

Needless to mention here that the competent **court of law has** issued Adoption Certificate in his favour and thereby he draws all the benefits which a son of his late father would have drawn

2. **Case of Smt. Malkit Kaur** w/o late Shri Karnail Singh S/o Sh. Hira S/wala RLy Hospital, JUDW –appointment on Compassionate grounds.

Sh.Karnail Singh who was working as Safailwala in Railway Hospital, JUDW is missing since 4/10/2004. All the efforts to trace him remained unsuccessful and ultimately Smt. Malkit Kaur lodged the report in the respective Police Stations where he was also declared as “Untraceable “

Union, therefore, desires that the above cases may kindly be looked into on top priority so that the aggrieved families may get justice

3. **Case of Shri Sachin Kumar** S/o Shri Hari Chand on compassionate grounds- on account of his father declared medically unfit for all categories.

Shri Sachin Kumar S/o Shri Hari chand is the only son has been considered for appointment on compassionate grounds after medically decategorization of SHri Hari Chand. Since due to lack of knowledge and misguided by some person he produced bogus educational certificate which was lateron rejected at the time of verification. Now SHri Sachin Kumar has passed the 8<sup>th</sup> class from recognized school and on enquiry the education certificate so produced has been found correct and in order.

Union, therefore, desires that the case of Shri Sachin Kumar may be considered sympathetically as his father Sh. Hari chand has lost his total vision and there is no other earning member in the family.

GM PNM Item NO. 35

Sub : Request of Shri Laxman Singh, STE under SS/MB for arranging payment of wages for the period of Suspension and removal from Service regularized as duty-assignment of seniority and grant of promotion in face of juniors.

It has been reported to this office that Shri Laxman Singh Dsl.Asstt. under SSE/Loco MB , when he was working on Express Train No. 4650 DN on 15/12/92, a bus was dashed at Gate No. 404 B and as a result he was placed under suspension w.e.f. 16/12/92 and remained under suspension upto to 29/3/1993. He was awarded the punishment of removal from service by Sr. DME/MB vide NIP NO. 333 T/2/11/92TA dated : 28/2/94 and a Civil case was also filed against him in the court of Civil Judge/MB.

Pursuant to his appeal the punishment of removal from service was reduced to that of reduction to the post of Fitter by the Appellate authority viz : ADRM/MB. Later on due to closure of the Loco, he having been rendered surplus & redeployed as Ticket Collector and with the passage of time he was progressed to the post of STE. Subsequently, on his acquittal by the Civil Court the period of his suspension w.e.f. 16/12/92 to 29/3/93 and the period of his removal from service from 28/2/94 to 17/6/94 have been regularized as duty by the Discipline Authority viz Sr. DME/MB vide letter NO. M-9/33-T/11/92/TA dated : 25/11/09.

Union, therefore, desires that keeping in view facts narrated above and regularization of the period of suspension and removal from service as duty, the following benefits having been treated as duty be granted to him without further loss of time

1. Seniority as due be assigned to him
2. Payment of wages for the aforesaid periods
3. Promotion as due in terms of the seniority & in face of the juniors to him promoted during the course of his suspension and removal from service

GM PNM Item No. 36/10

Sub : Compassionate ground Appointment cases.

Shri Iswar Dass s/o Shri Birbal , Tech. I T.NO.649-Kalka Workshop was medically de-categorized for all categories vide L.NO. 99-Med/8/319 23/1/2007 after due approval from CMD/New Delhi but, unluckily , his ward Shri Rajesh Kumar has not been offered any appointment due to wrong interpretation of PS No. 13229/13167 by CWM/CLK , who rejected his application dt,28/4/2007. Since then the poor and aggrieved employee is running from pillar to post and not getting justice from any corner.

All the relevant documents has already sent to Hqrs. Office vide this office letter No. NRMU/12/2010 dt.19/5/2010 for consideration and taking up the same at appropriate level and his son named Shri Rajesh Kumar be given an appointment on Railway on compassionate grounds keeping in view pitiable condition of the employee and his family too.

Union, therefore desires that the above case may please be looked into on top priority and necessary orders be issued for appointment of above named to avoid mental agony and financial crisis to the aggrieved family.

GM PNM Item NO. 37

Sub : Delaying tactics in finalization of Medical Reimbursement cases.

The above matter has been discussed in various FORAs threadbare that there has been number of complaints in finalization of medical reimbursement cases/claims thereof. Number of cases are being delayed on one plea or the other.

Union, therefore, desires that these cases may please be given top priority as the family of the deceased already faced on ailments and financial crises and they may not be further harassed on this account

Some of the glaring cases are given below which may please be looked into personally and be sorted at the earliest to avoid mental agony to the bereaved family

GM PNM Item No.38/10

Sub : Extension of tenure of part time Dental Surgeon  
In Railway Divl.Hospital, Moradabad.

It has been reported to this office by our Divisional unit at Moradabad that Dr. Gautam Rastogi has been working as Dental Surgeon on part time basis for four hours daily for the last 8 years in the Divl. Railway Hospital, MB on tenure basis with the entire satisfaction of patients as well as administration. This tenure have been extended on periodical basis with the approval of the competent authority. His present tenure has expired on 19/2/2010 and as such sanction for extension of the tenure beyond 19/2/2010 is required. In this connection an appeal dt. 22/2/2010 from Dr. Gautam Rastogi seeking for sanction of extension of the tenure is enclosed for consideration.

Since the employees of MB Division & their family members are facing a lot on this account, therefore Union desires that necessary approval of the competent authority for extension of the tenure be communicated at the earliest to avoid unrest there.

GM PNM Item No. 39/2010

Sub : Proper supply of Electricity to Gang Huts.

It has been reported to this office that in the State of Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh , the electricity connection of gang huts was attached with village electricity feeder , where load shedding was very less. Now this connection has been changed to that of Agricultural electricity feeder line where 17/18 hours no electricity is available. The ASMs, Gangmen and other staff working the area are put to unnecessary hardship , due to this problem.

Union, therefore, desires that the above problem may be looked into on top priority and remedial measures be taken to get rid of the problems.

GM PNM Item NO. 40/10

Sub : Out of turn promotion to Sh. Satpal , Luggage Porter  
-International Sportsman.

It has been represented to this office by our Divisional Branch at Ambala that the out of turn promotion case of Shri Satpal , Luggage Porter,Ambala has not been considered by the competent authority so far . It Needless to mention here that he is an International Sports person and his case for out of turn promotion is pending in Hqrs. Office since long but action on which is still awaited.

Similarly the case of Shri Narender Singh, Safaiwala, Comml. -of FZR Division is also pending in HQ Office since long. He has won 3 GOLD MEDALS.

Union, therefore, desires that the above case may please be looked into and orders for their promotion out of turn be issued at the earliest.

GM PNM Item No. 41/2010

Sub : Redeployment of Vehicle Drivers of TMC Organization.

There are 14 Vehicle Drivers functioning in TMC Organisation in different pay grades on one vehicle at this time. One Truck and Two Jeeps have been declared condemned by the competent authority. Some of the Vehicle drivers, numbering about 7 ) directly controlled by the Secy. To PCE. Secretary, to PCE has spared two vehicles Drivers to Dy. CE/TMC/Line by declaring them surplus by pick & choose policy. Now these drivers are functioning on different Track machines and TMM depots at LKO and TKD without any proper training of Track Machines. Their category has not so far been changed, while they have given in writing for change of category and for posting in TMC Organization as Technician with inter-se seniority.

Union, therefore, demand that Vehicle Drivers of TMC Organization should be redeployed on different Track Machines or in TMM Depots by adopting the proper procedure.

GM PNM Item No. 42/2010

Sub : Promotion of TMC Staff from Pay Band Rs. `9300-34800  
With Grade Pay Rs. 4200 to Rs. 4600.

Recently " P " Branch have promoted 29 JE II & JE I working in Pay Band Rs. 9300-34800 Pay grade Rs. 4200 to 4600 as SE/TMC by calculating the vacancies upto 31/8/2009 as per the extant order of the Railway Board. There are total sanctioned vacancies of JE II, JE I, SE, SSE of TMC organization are 223 prior to 31/8/2009 , whereas the calculation has been done by P Branchy on less vacancies at the time of promotion from pay Gr. Rs. 4200-4600. It appears that the correct number of vacancies in the category of SE Gr. Pay Rs. 4600/- have not been taken into consideration by the P Branch.

Union, therefore, demand that the calculation , should be done again on 223 vacancies so that the deprived staff be also get the benefit of promotion.

GM PNM item no. 43/10

Sub : Absence of Running Staff from Headquarters

Railway Board vide their letter No. E(LL ) 2009/HER/1 DAED : 26/2/2010 have issued instructions to all GMs –Indian Railways that all cases of absence of more than 36 hours of Running staff from Hqrs. Be monitored closely with a view to restrict such absence within reasonable limits.

In this connection, Board have also quoted a reference of their previous letter No. E(LL)/97/HER/11 dated : 30/9/1998 wherein the Railways were asked to keep a close watch at the Divl. Level and also periodically at Zonal level to reduce the period of absence of running staff from the Headquarters.

The instructions contained in Board's letter, supra, dated : 30/9/1998 were not implemented on Northern Railway, resulting into AIRF again raised the subject matter at Board's level and the Board vide their letter ibid, dt. 26/2/2010 reiterated their earlier instructions for reducing the absence of running staff from Hqrs. by monitoring closely all cases of absence of more than 36 hours from Hqrs.

Union, therefore, desires that a Committee be constituted at the Zonal level under the PREM Group to consider and workout the modalities for restricting the absence of running staff from Headquarters to implement Board's instruction in true spirit and arrange to issue further guidelines to the Divisions to follow the same.

GM PNM Item No.44/10

Sub : MACP Benefits to Smt.Sunita Sahni, AA under TA Office,JUC.

Smt. Sunita Sahni, AA under Traffic Accounts Office, JUC was appointed as Stenographer in Feby. 1980 in scale Rs. 1200-2040 ( GP Rs. 2800 ) and first promotion was given to her in May 1991 in the scale of Rs. 1400-2600 ( Grade Pay Rs. 4200) as Accounts Assistant. This was only

change of category. After implementation of 6<sup>th</sup> CPC , both the scales i.e. Rs. 5000-8000 and Rs.5500-9000 have been merged.

Thus in totality, after her appointment in scale Rs.1200-2040 { Grade Pay Rs.2800 }, she got only one promotion because both the scales fall in grade pay Rs. 4200/- where as administration is considering their two promotion. Thereafter administration gave her third MACP with grade Pay Rs. 4600/-which is not correct.

Union, therefore, desire the above case may please be examined in the light of facts narrated above and arrange to give her the third MACP which is also due to her with effect from Feby. 2010 to afford justice to her.

GM PNM Item NO. 45

Sub : **Compassionate ground appointment to Sh.Narinder Nyar.**

It has been represented to this office that Shri Mohan Kumar S/o Shri Vasu Dev, OHE/Tower Wagon Driver was declared medically unfit vide L.NO. 54-Med/MB/MK/DLI dated : 16/12/2003- 23/12/2003 by the competent authority. Thereafter he requested for CG Appointment to his daughter. Accordingly the administration given appointment to her but as ill luck would have it she also died on 29/5/2008. The family of deceased is facing lot of hardship. Shri Mohan Kumar is suffering from paralytic attack on 7/8/2008. Shri Mohan Kumar submitted an application for appointment of his son Sh. Narinder Nyar to DRM/Delhi but nothing has been heard till date.

Union, therefore, desires that the case of SHri Mohan Kumar , Tower Wagon Driver, OHE/Panipat may please be considered and Shri Narinder Nyar, his son, be offered an appointment on compassionate ground at the earliest being a hard pressed case.

GM PNM Item No. 46/10

Sub : CG Appointment to SHri Rakesh Kumar adopted son  
Of late SHri Khanni Pd. Shukla, STE/News Delhi.

Shri Khanni Pd. Shukla, STE/New Delhi while in service died on 1/10/1996 & having no issue the late employee adopted Shri Rakash Kumar, his son, by " Registered Adoption Deed " in the court on 21/12/1993 prior to his death and duly accepted by Divl. Administration (DRM/DLI )

Poor widow Smt.Suraj Pati, w/o of late Shri Khanni Pd. Shukla having very minor child submitted application that her son Sh. Rakesh Kumar may kindly be given CG Appointment on his maturity which was accepted by Divl. Administration . Widow is continuously representing to DRM/Delhi for appointment of her adopted son since 2007 i.e. after maturity , but all in vain.

Union, therefore, demands that the above case may please be looked into and consider CG Appointment of SHri Rakesh Kumar, adopted son of late Shri Khanni Pd. Shukla as the widow now-a-days is passing very hard days & eagerly waiting for her bread winner for looking after in her old age.

GM PNM Item NO. 47/10

Sub : Restoration of Smt. Madhulika Water Women  
Under IOW/E/Ambala.

Smt. Madhulika who belongs to upper caste by birth, married to a youth of Schedule Caste status of her husband. She was appointed as Water Women against the Schedule caste quota, but later on, some body reported against her that the appointment is false and she had concealed the facts of being scheduled caste by birth. On enquiry the fact seems to be correct, resulting in she was removed from service and ultimately she knocked the door of Hon'ble Court /CDG which also dismissed her appeal with the remarks that if the administration so desire, her request can be considered because of her long service.

Union, therefore, desire that the case of Smt. Madhulika may be considered and for her reinstatement be issued on the basis of CAT/CGD 's recommendation and her longer stay in railway as well.

GM PNM Item NO. 48/10

Sub : Revision of Food Charges for the Breakdown Staff as per 6<sup>th</sup> CPC Recommendations.

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The staff required to attend Breakdown duties are currently being paid the following rates of Food Charges :-

Breakfast @ Rs.18/- per head  
Lunch @ Rs.25/- per head  
Evening tea @ Rs. 3/- per head  
Dinners @ Rs.25/-per head

Consequent upon implementation of 6<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations it has become necessary to revise these charges keeping in view the high rise prices.

Union, therefore, demands that Food Charges of the above noted items may be revised and notified for information of all concerned.

Shri Kanahaiya Lal S/o Shri Shiv Lal being medically de-categorized for the post of Guard grade Rs. 5000-8000(RSRP) was found fit for absorption as Section Controller in grade of Rs 5500-9000 (RSRP ) by the Screening Committee through DRM/LKO's L.No. 515E/68/CL-iii/Med.de-categorized dated : 4/4/2008. Lateron, his alternative posting was revised on administrative ground from the post of Section Controller

to Parcel Supervisor in grade Rs. 5500-9000 in Comml. Deptt. Vide DRM/LKO's letter of even number dt. 6/8/08. After passing pre-requisite training CP-7, he was posted as Parcel Supervisor in grade Rs. 5500-9000 (RSRP) /revised grade pay Rs. 4200 vide DRM/P -LKO's letter of even number dt. 8/3/2008.

Under the 6<sup>th</sup> CPC Report both the grades , i.e. 5000-8000 (RSRP ) & 5500-9000 have since been merged in grade pay of Rs. 4200. This Union had demanded that since SH.,Kanahiya Lal, was working as Guard in grade Rs. 5000-8000 (RSRP) + revised grade pay Rs. 4200, he may be given one higher grade pay of Rs. 4600/- as per his absorption from running category to stationary category. The matter had been referred to the Hqrs. Office for necessary instruction but nothing has been heard till date.

Union, therefore, demands that the above issue may please be looked into and necessary instructions be issued to DRM/LKO to grant grade pay of Rs. 4600/- to Shri Kanahiya Lal , keeping in view of extant rules regarding allowing weightage to the running staff in cases of their alternative posting on stationary post without further loss of time.

GM PNM Item NO. 55/10

Sub : Provision of Community Centre at ASR & Ludhiana.

It has been represented to this office that at present there is no Community Centre at Amritsar and Ludhiana whwre as in these colonies near about 10000 railway employees and their families at ASR and 15000 employees & their family members at LDH are residing. It is to mention that due to increase in Traffic volume during last few years this Union is continuously representing the issue for conducting factual job analysis of Gateman deployed at LC No. 2-B under SS/Vyasnagar through Divl.PNM against item NO. 970. In turn a FJ was ordered by the Divl.administration at LKO and was conducted on and from 26/2/2009 to 1/3/2009 . As a result of FJ the classification of gate working was found to be changed from essential intermittent to continuous and the report was accepted by the competent authority at the Divl. Level. It was got vetted too. On union persuasion the Divl.administration sent the case to Hqrs. Office to approve the change in respect of classification from essentially intermittent to that of continuous vide DRM/P LKO's letter No. 2-E/Adj/FJ/Gate man/09 dt.21/10/2009 but it is matter serious concern but the change as asked for, has not been approved till date.

Union, therefore, demands that the above issue may be looked into on top priority basis and arrange to communicate necessary approval for change of classification of Gate, as asked for vide this office letter dt.12/4/2010, supra, & as asked for vide DRM/LKO's letter NO. 2E/Adj./FJA/Gateman/09 dt.2/10/09 without further loss of time.

Sub : Cancellation of transfer orders.

Please refer to this office letter No.NRMU/8/2010 dt.10/6/2010 on the subject in which the appeal of Shri Shiv Dutt Bajpai, Hd.
